An insurance claim and sheriff's office report have been filed, but due to our insurance deductible of \$2500, we will be covering the entire cost of repair which could cost as much as \$2000. We are currently investigating outside security cameras, especially on the southwest corner near the playground which is somewhat hidden. Also note that sometime after Christmas Eve, extension cords, dusk-to-dawn timer, and flood lights were removed from the front manager scene.
