FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Do not be afraid.

All four Gospels record accounts of the resurrection of Jesus, and of the people who witnessed that Jesus rose from the dead, and of his empty tomb. Each gospel writer also wrote the angelic message uniquely according to the context of their faith community so that those reading might grow their faith in the power of the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Here is the message of the angel:

"Do not be afraid." (Matthew 28:5)

"Don't be alarmed." (Mark 16:6)

"Why do you look for the living among the dead?" (Luke 24:5)

"Woman, why are you crying?" (John 20:13)

The Gospel of Matthew records that on the first day of the week after Jesus died on the cross, two women went to the tomb. There was a violent earthquake, and an angel of the Lord whose appearance was like lightning with clothes as white as snow appeared and rolled the stone away and sat on it. The guards were afraid of the angel. They shook and became like dead men. At this scene, the two women were also afraid, and the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here, he has risen, just as he said." (Matthew 28:5-6)

What are we afraid of?

We are afraid of death. We are afraid of the power of sin. We are afraid of uncertainty of the future. We are afraid of a painful past. We are afraid of illness in body and mind. We are afraid of loneliness. We are afraid of the heavy burden of daily life. We are afraid of broken relationships.

Reflect on your own fears and fill in the blank, "I am afraid of ______."

And meditate on the message of the resurrection of Jesus according to the Gospel of Matthew.

The message of the resurrection of Jesus, "He has risen, just as he said" (Matthew 28:6), brings us good news today, giving strength, so that we can live through fear and anxiety with faith, hope, love, and joy, like the two women at the tomb on the first Easter morning. "So the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with joy, and ran to tell his disciples" (Matthew 28: 8). Post-resurrection stories in the Bible continue to witness to this good news, and we receive it today.

May the Lord who has risen bless you and keep you. Happy and blessed Easter to you all.



On **Thursday, April 14 at 7:00 p.m.** the sanctuary choir will perform the cantata *Colors of Grace* by Joseph M. Martin.
