

Pandemic thoughts.

I watched a YouTube video in which a medical doctor lectured on why we should keep our blood vessels clean so that we can live a healthy life. He asked three ice-breaking questions. "How many diseases do humans have?" According to the International Disease Classification, he said, there are 12,420 kinds of diseases in human life. "What is the most common disease?" It is gum disease, called periodontitis. "What is the most invasive disease?" It is Rabies, he said. Then he asked, "What is the worst disease you don't want to get sick from?" The cruelest and most fearful disease, which most seriously destroys quality of life, he thinks, is stroke, leading to paralysis, one of the vascular diseases. If you want to live a healthy life, he concluded, you must keep your blood vessels clean. Then he suggested a very basic thing for our blood vessels to stay clean: it is aerobic exercising every day for at least 30 minutes, done consistently. It is simple, basic, but it is very important for us to live a healthy life.

As we have been through the COVID-19 virus pandemic for over two years, I reflect on "what does God teach us from this pandemic situation, a lesson we learn for our faith, spiritual life, and our relationship with God, to stay healthy?" Out of many lessons, I think, it is to return to basics. We don't know how long the pandemic will last. We can't predict if it will end someday or not. But either way, God has called us to return to the basics of our faith by renewing our relationship to God, resetting the value and goal of life, returning to basic spiritual practices by recovering our worship, praying constantly, reading and meditating on the Word of God, loving and serving each other by doing no harm, doing good, and staying in love with God three simple rules which are called the Wesleyan way of life.

Bible Reading Plan 2022 is our basic spiritual practice, returning to the word of God. Since January we have read through Genesis, a story of beginning—the beginning of the heaven and earth, of the covenant of God, of the redemption of God— and we know God who is the center of our life.
