FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Mother's love.

An English writer, Rudyard Kipling, wrote a poetic expression about mother's love, "God could not be everywhere, and therefore he made mothers." It is his figurative expression of mother's love, linking it to the love of God. Mother's love originated from God.

Isaiah prophesies the motherly love of God to suffering people, "Can a mother forget the baby or the child she has born? Though she may forget I will not forget you!" (Isaiah 49:15). We come to know God's love through our mother's love. It is life-giving, life-forgiving love, and unconditional and sacrificial love.

May is Christian Home month, and this year we celebrate Mother's Day on May 8. I remember red and pink carnations at my home church when I was a child. It was a tradition that we used them on Mother's Day, when all mothers were recognized during worship and each carnation was given to them in honor of their love. I still remember my mother's happy smile at me when I gave her a carnation, saying, "Happy Mother's Day."


"God bless all mothers and women" is a prayer and petition on Mother's Day in the United Methodist Book of Worship. Let us join in praying, with silent prayer following each petition:

Let the example of their faith and love shine forth. Grant that we, their sons and daughters, may honor them always with a spirit of profound respect. Grant this through Christ our Lord. Amen."
