135 Years of Bethany History

Did you know that Edward A. Jenkins, one of Bethany's "Founding Fathers", donated the iron bell for the original steeple built by members of the church in 1940?

This is the same bell that came crashing down and rolled down the aisle during the devastating fire that destroyed the church building in January 1982. An important artifact in the history of Bethany, the bell now hangs in the brick wall opening in front of the church.
