135 Years of Bethany History

Did you know that in the early '70s, Bethany embarked on two major building projects: a new \$31,000 parsonage and a \$50,000 education unit? The education wing, not attached to the original church and built approximately where the current education building is located, included an office for the minister and a bulletin-preparation room along with classrooms. The last loan payment was made one year ahead of schedule, and an impressive "note-burning" ceremony took place in January 1977, with Bishop Goodson presiding. Charred remnants of the note are on display in the Mary Lotsey Classroom.
