135 Years of Bethany History

NOTE ON "MIDSUMMER" MUSIC

In Europe June 24th is celebrated as the saint's day of John the Baptist, also known as "Midsummer Day" because it occurs near the summer solstice. According to a tradition recorded by Sir James Frazer in *The Golden Bough*, the preceding night was believed to be a time when witches and other supernatural beings caused widespread mischief.

This is the setting of Shakespeare's play *A Midsummer Night's Dream*, and the famous *Wedding March* comes from the music Felix Mendelssohn composed for a production of the drama in 1843. As Franz Liszt later commented, "There was no one who could match Mendelssohn's ability to depict the rainbow haze and nacreous sheen of these tiny goblins, no one who could reproduce the vivid brilliance of a wedding celebration at court as well as he." — Rudy Shackelford
