135 Years of Bethany History

Did you know that between 1978 and 1980, Bethany embarked on an \$85,000 remodeling plan? The project included an enlarged chancel and sanctuary, narthex, pews, sconces, carpet, bell tower and steeple, aluminum siding, storm windows, enlarged front steps, and the blacktopping of parking lots and the entrance road.

At the time, little did we know that Bethany would enjoy the completed renovations for only two years before tragedy would strike.

Hugh Harris served as pastor at Bethany Church from June, 1972 to June, 1975. In 1999 he retired from Ramsey Memorial UMC in Richmond. During retirement he has served three short-term interim pastorates, plus a five-year appointment to Willis UMC in Eastern Henrico County. He has also worked on various church staffs in the Richmond area.

A life-long artist, Hugh has continued to pursue this passion in retirement, currently having a gallery wall at Crossroads Art Center in Richmond. In addition, he has published several books, including three novels in his Dinkel Island Series. In 2013 he and his late wife, Sharon, published a book, "NPH: Journey into Dementia and Out Again," about their experience with a debilitating cognitive condition.

Sharon died on September 4, 2021, after a ten-year struggle with various health issues. Hugh and Nancy Cunningham met in a widow/widowers Hospice support group and were married in January of this year. They live in retired clergy housing in North Chesterfield.
