135 Years of Bethany History

The Fire (01/16/82, continued): Did you know that the Building Committee selected the Newport News architectural firm of Caro, Monroe and Liang (AIA) and contractor Peyton Hall for the church building and new Fellowship Hall? Members were surveyed for input regarding all aspects of the reconstruction, and the Committee visited 15 churches to gather ideas. The Building Committee met 57 times to iron out construction details of the two buildings and how the Education Building, which was not affected by the fire, would be incorporated into the design.
