135 YEARS OF BETHANY HISTORY

Did you know that a young, Christian couple from Russia found their way to Bethany in 1986?

Lorna and Slav Monastyrly escaped by boat from the former U.S.S.R. to Germany. They attended a Methodist Church there whose minister was the daughter of Mrs. Jeanette Bass of Gloucester. Mrs. Bass volunteered to sponsor the couple in the United States, and the Monastyrlys chose Bethany as their church home after Mr. and Mrs. Lacey Martin introduced them to our church community ... a prime example of Bethany's mission of "open hearts, minds, and doors."
