Note on Music for Lent

Samuel Barber is one of America's most renowned composers, and three of his works appear regularly in services at Bethany: Adagio for Strings on Memorial Day; Chorale Prelude on "Silent Night" on Christmas Eve; and during Lent his "Wondrous Love": Variations on a Shape-note Hymn, created in 1959. The modal tune was borrowed from a secular song about the famous pirate Captain Kidd and first appeared as a hymn in William Walker's Southern Harmony (1835). The text is a meditation on Christ's love, so great that he would give up His crown for a sinner's soul.

Samuel Barber's four variations on What Wondrous Love Is This (UMH No. 292) mirror the mood and meaning of the hymn's four stanzas with sensitivity and finesse the equal of Johann Sebastian Bach in his variations on Lutheran chorales. Springing from such a venerable tradition, the blues-tinged music Barber composed for the final stanza of Wondrous Love gains a special poignancy and resonance: "And when from death I'm free, I'll sing on, and through eternity I'll sing on."

As a young organist looking to impress the world with his phenomenal talent, Bach composed virtuoso showpieces titled toccata (meaning "to touch" in Italian), including two in the key of D minor. Our Offertory today, while less famous than the Halloween favorite *Toccata in* D Minor, BWV 565, even more powerfully evokes imagery of Gothic horror: the relentless galloping motion suggests a musical depiction of the Four Horsemen of the Apocalypse from the *Revelation of St. John.* Perhaps this interpretation is speculative, but this *Toccata* seems to invite conjecture. It was nicknamed "Dorian" by someone who mistook the lack of B-flat in the key signature as an indication that the music conforms to the ancient Greek Dorian mode!

Our dear, departed friend and choir member Bob Reid especially enjoyed listening to Bach's "Dorian" Toccata, so we dedicate this performance to his memory.
